Membership Criteria

To be eligible for corporate membership, an organization must...

- offer or plan to offer French-language health services in Eastern or South-Eastern Ontario and receive funds from a public source in Ontario
- belong to one of the following categories:
 - hospitals
 - community care access centres, community support services, or other organizations offering health-related services
 - community addictions and mental health agencies
 - community health centres, public health centres and primary care agencies
 - long-term care facilities
 - post-secondary institutions that offer healthcare education
