Benefits of Corporate Membership

By means of an authorized representative, corporate members get:

- Regular updates on access to French-language health services in Eastern and South-Eastern Ontario
- A unique opportunity to share their organizations' points of view, to participate in recommendations for improving healthcare services in French, and to support projects to improve the health of Francophones
- The opportunity to be involved in French-language healthcare planning

Membership Criteria

To be eligible for corporate membership, an organization must...

- offer or plan to offer French-language health services in Eastern or South-Eastern Ontario and receive funds from a public source in Ontario
- belong to one of the following categories:

hospitals
community care access centres, community support services, or other organizations offering health-related services
community addictions and mental health agencies
community health centres, public health centres and primary care agencies
long-term care facilities
post-secondary institutions that offer healthcare education
